
## Las Colinas Country Club – Patio/Dining Deck and Interior Dining Area

Action > The client was seeking extensive interior and exterior renovations to be completed in time for a pre-scheduled, presidential event. The scope of the exterior renovation work included an outdoor patio/dining deck with a fire pit site work, the construction of an "overhang" and the installation of flat screen TV's and ceiling fans. The interior renovations included an existing dining area and the addition of a bar, a media room, two conference rooms, a pre-function room, two new restrooms and office space.
